Enrollment Guide for International Chinese
Language Teachers Scholarship-Master of
Translation Training Program for Foreigners
(2023)

I. OBJECTIVES

The program aims to cultivate high-level bilingual and applied talents who are proficient in Chinese, familiar with Chinese culture and skilled in translation techniques.

II. ELIGIBILITY

All applicants shall be:

- a) Non-Chinese citizens;
- b) Should be friendly to China, have no criminal record, and abide by the laws and regulations of the Chinese government and the rules and regulations of BISU;
- c) In good physical and mental conditions, and with good moral and academic performance;
- d) Age below 40 years old (as of September 1st, 2023).

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants shall:

- a) Hold a Bachelor's degree or above in Chinese, translation, etc.;

- b) Have a minimum score of 180 on the HSK Test (Level 6);
- c) Mother tongue is Spanish, French, or Arabic;
- d) Experience in translation is preferred;
- e) The program commences in September 2023 and provides scholarships for a maximum of 2 academic years.

IV. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

(I) Application Period

From April 1, 2023 to June 30, 2023.

(II) Application Process

a) Applicants shall log on the International Chinese Language Teacher Scholarship website (www.chinese.cn) and submit application materials online.

b) Applicants shall also register and apply online through the International Student Online Service System of BISU (<http://apply.bisu.edu.cn/>). After registration, applicants should follow the instructions to log into the system and provide required information as detailed in Annex 1.

c) Interview will be organized by BIUS for qualified applicants. Applicants should track the application progress, review comments and result.

d) CENTER FOR LANGUAGE EDUCATION AND COOPERATION will entrust an expert panel to review the applications and announce the results.

e) Scholarship winners need to confirm with BISU to go through the procedures for studying in China, print out the scholarship certificate, and register in BISU on the designated date as specified in the admission letter.

V. Academic Structure and Degree

The basic academic term of the Program is two years. Upon completion of required course credits and passing the assessments as well as qualified internship and practice, and passing thesis defense, students will be awarded a degree of Master of Arts and issued with a degree certificate and diploma.

VI. Content of Scholarship Support

a) Tuition fees, accommodation fees, living expenses and comprehensive medical insurance for Master of Translation Training Program for Foreigners.

b) Among them, the accommodation fee, living expenses and comprehensive medical insurance of the scholarship students of CENTER FOR LANGUAGE EDUCATION AND COOPERATION shall be implemented in accordance with the relevant standards of International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship

VII. OTHERS

a) Scholarship winners are subject to the annual assessment according to the Annual Appraisal Procedures of International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship.

b) Students who fail to pass the pre-enrollment medical examination, withdraw from the program midway, or fail to register on time or suspend their studies without permission will be disqualified from the scholarship.
